Serving on the board requires time and dedication, some positions more than others. If more residents volunteer, even a little, it can reduce the workload for those carrying the heaviest loads. Thank you in advance for considering lending a hand.

We have had some technical issues with updates to the MOMA website, but we hope these will be resolved by the time you read this.

If you see a problem around the community, there are several things you can do. If a situation seems dangerous, don't take chances, call 911 immediately. For non-emergency situations call 727-847-8102, option 7.

This will get you to dispatch. This number is operated 24/7. You might need to let it ring for a while.

To report a pothole, call 727-847-2411. This is the Pasco County main number. The operator will direct you to the correct person or take your report. You can also use the MyPasco app.

To report a street light outage, call Withlacoochee River Electric at 727-868-9465. You will need to report the address and the number located on the light pole.

4-5:30 – Gathering on the patio at The Oak Tavern/Meadow Oaks Golf Course.

Need to rent a cart? No problem, see the information below. Private carts please sign up at MO clubhouse or call Brenda 813-909-3756, let us know if you have lights.

4-5:45 Time for cart renters to decorate carts.

5:30 Need all carts present to begin the line up and give people time to look carts over and vote.

VOTE: Vote for your 3 fa-

vorite carts. Someone will lead and make a lot of noise to let our residents know we are on our way.

6PM Start by circling the restaurant clubhouse for those attending to see and cast their votes for best decorations

6:10 the parade will go down the 1st fairway – the front nine will take roughly 40 minutes.

6:50ish we will circle back to the Clubhouse restaurant, circle around and then take a break, enjoy some drinks and award the winners.

7PM all votes for your favorite carts must be in.
