We hope all is well with you as we head into October. We have some projects in the works and some that have been accomplished. We hope this helps keep you informed as to what is happening in Meadow Oaks.

Both bathrooms in the pool area, along with the entryway, have had new tile installed with the floors being leveled and at the proper pitch to drains.

A new bench has been ordered and will arrive soon for across the street from the 17th green.

We have some stains on the carpet in the clubhouse from water. New gutters will address the water problem. That project is in the works. We are also working on the stains. We will get that information out upon completion.

Nancy Trio will be stepping down from her volunteer position of managing the key fobs for Meadow Oaks. She has done an excellent job and worked hard on our transition to our new system. Thank you, Nancy, for your work and patience. A few people have stepped up to take over this position. We will be contacting you soon to get training. Thank you for volunteering.

For non-emergency situations call 727-847-8102, option 7. This will get you to dispatch. This number is operated 24/7. You might need to let it ring for a while.

From the Woodview Village Board of Directors

Some of you have received letters from our management company regarding clean up on your property. Please know that you are not being singled out, this is simply a routine part of owning a home with a Homeowners Association (HOA) and established guidelines.

If you believe you received a letter in error, please contact Gail Dasher at Sentry Management at gdasher@sentrymgt.com. In most cases, the issue is something that a homeowner may not notice until it is pointed out. That seems to be especially true of weeds in the yard and gardens.

Please remember that sidewalks, boulevards in front of homes, and driveways are the responsibility of the homeowner and must be kept clean.

In addition, personal items must be stored indoors. Items should not be kept along the sides of homes or visible from the street as outlined in our covenants: **4.4 OUTSIDE STORAGE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY:** The personal property of any resident of the SUBJECT PROPERTY shall be kept inside the resident's HOME or a screened-in lanai or the owner's garage.

Garbage has become a problem on some streets. On garbage pick-up days, please place garbage in sealed trash containers rather than loose bags. Bags left out can be torn open by animals, creating a mess in the street that can affect everyone. Using proper containers keeps our neighborhood clean and safe. Please also remember not to place trash containers at the curb before 5:00 p.m. the day prior to pick-up.

Thank you all for taking care of your property and our neighborhood. It does take continuing effort, but it also helps keep our property values up.



To report a pothole, call 727-847-2411. This is the Pasco County main number. The operator will direct you to the correct person or take your report. You can also use the MyPasco app.

To report a street light outage, call Withlacoochee River

Electric at 727-868-9465. You will need to report the address and the number located on the light pole.
